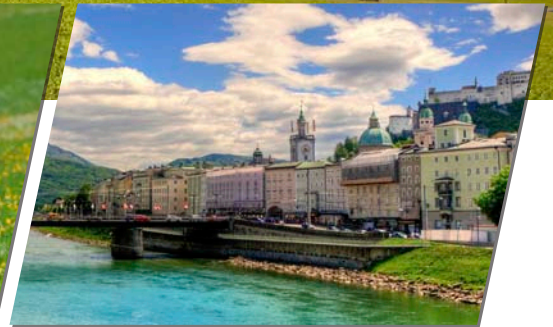
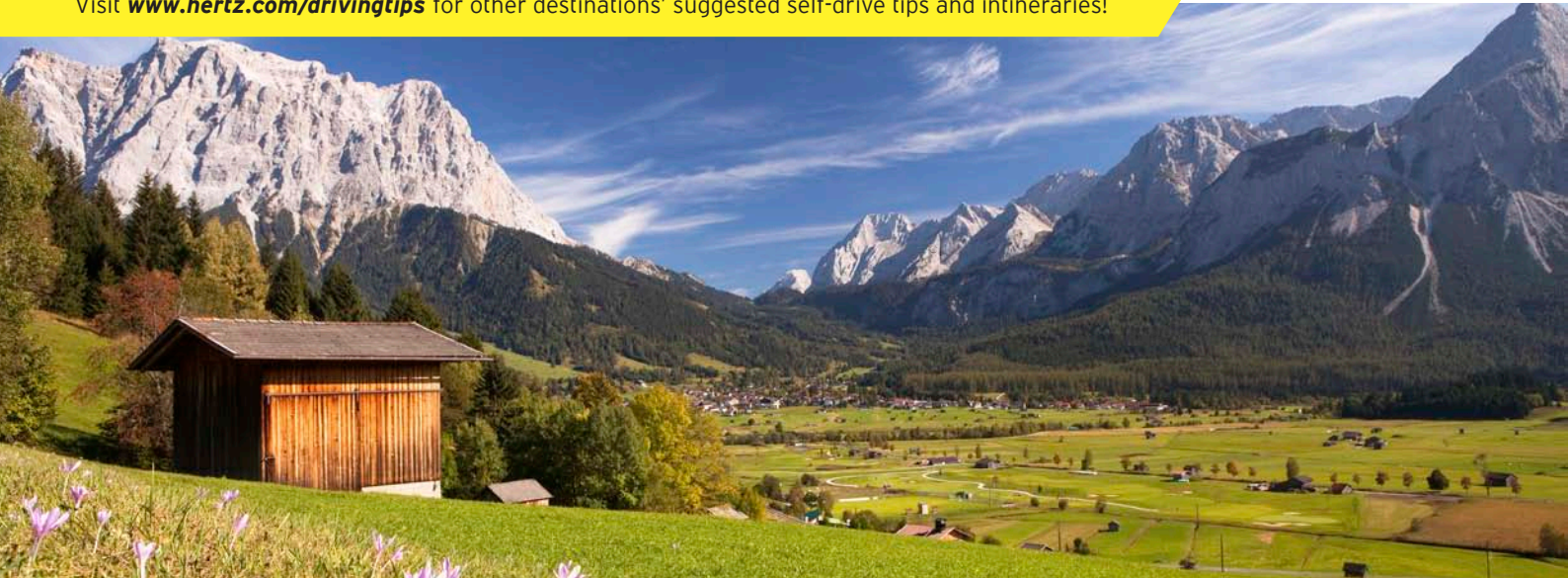

## Self-drive Tips

All Austrian motorways ('Autobahn') and 'S' roads are subject to toll. A Motorway Vignette (toll sticker) is required when driving in Austria. This is a road tax disk stuck on the windshield to prove that tolls have been paid. Vignettes can be purchased at petrol stations at the border or at the local tourist office or post office. The use of the horn is generally prohibited in Vienna.

Drivers must stop their vehicle and wait for an audible warning if approaching a level crossing with a white sign featuring a train engine and the words "auf pfeifsignal achten".
