



As shared on January 13, your Hertz supplier access will transition from iSupplier to the **new Oracle Cloud Supplier Portal** as part of Hertz's overall move from its legacy Oracle software to the cloud-based Oracle suite on February 1st.

As a former iSupplier user, you will have access to the new Hertz Supplier Portal beginning February 1st.

Note that your iSupplier access has been discontinued as part of this transition. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and value our partnership with you.

Accessing Oracle Cloud Supplier and Navigation

Beginning February 1st, click <https://fa-evlf-saasfaprod1.fa.ocs.oraclecloud.com> to access the Oracle Supplier Portal.

Your User ID will be the email account through which you've received this email (i.e., your previous iSupplier email account) and you will need to select 'forgot password' the first time you access the system.
