## Self-drive Tips

**Toll Pass** – An E-toll Pass is recommended for use by visitors to Sydney. Alternatively, you may get the Hertz Toll Day Pass.

**Obstacles on the Road** – Take note of wildlife road signs warning motorists of the dangers of wandering native Australian animals (wallabies, wombats, emus, etc.), especially at dawn and at dusk.

**Fuel Stops** – You should plan ahead for fuel stops. Some petrol stations do not operate around the clock and have limited credit card facilities.
