### Self-drive Tips

Road Rules - In Victoria, the speed limit on the open road rises to 100 kilometres per hour (km/h) and, in some sections of freeway, 110 km/h.

Hook Turns - The hook turn is an unusual road rule specific to Melbourne. To ensure that trams get a clear way through some intersections, drivers turning right must do so from the left-hand lane.

Trams - Cars must always stop behind a tram when it is stationary and the doors are open for passengers getting on or off the tram.


