Self-drive Tips

Finland is the 8th largest country in Europe, it is also the most sparsely populated country in the European Union. Expect to cover large distances, often through landscapes devoid of human habitation, especially in Lapland.

Traffic and Driving – Right-hand traffic and no road tolls. Headlights must be used at all times. Snow tires are obligatory from December to February. The speed limit is usually 50 km/h inside built-up areas, 80 km/h outside built-up areas and up to 120 km/h for motorways.

Parking – A vehicle may be stopped or parked only on the right hand side of a road (except on a one way road).
